ONLY current Club Members or a signed in AMA Member (Guest) are permitted to fly at RCACF. Current Members that forget their Club ID are permitted and required to sign themselves in as a Guest.

This courtesy will be permitted only one time per Member. So please remember to keep your Club ID with your transmitter. If you see someone in the Pit area without a Badge speak up. Be friendly, educate them, promote the hobby and encourage them to become a current Club / AMA Member.

FULL SCALE ELECTRIC FLIGHT



An innovative, electric, full-size aircraft, developed by Rolls-Royce has claimed the title of the world's fastest electric aircraft. This machine has reached a top speed of 345 mph. This is amazing, because many of the techniques utilized for the development of this aircraft, will trickle down to R/C modeling!

The 'spirit of innovation' is propelled by a 400kW (500+hp) electric power-train and the most power-dense propulsion battery pack ever assembled in aerospace. Other specs include 2200rpm propeller rotation, 6480 battery cells, 750 volts system voltage, and a nemesis NXT airframe.
